******Market Park Remediation Works******

We have been advised that remediation works will commence at the parking area of the Market Park on Monday 01 April and will continue for 10 weeks. The nature of the materials excavated may create residual but non hazardous odours. The works will be managed to minimise the impact. However, please be aware that it will not be possible to eliminate this completely. While there may be some short to medium term disruption, the aim of these works is to clean up historical contamination. This will improve the environmental status of the site for the benefit of the town of Crieff and for future generations. The current entrance will be closed and used for site access only. Please note that a new entrance will be opened to allow continued access to a much smaller section of land near the large green shed so please park with consideration to other cars and pedestrians. If you have any questions regarding these works, a member of the project team, Darren Wood will be available every Tuesday evening from 6pm on site, commencing Tuesday, 9 April 2019.
