- ► ECS Revenue Budget £212.418m.
- ► Recurring Pressures of £3.042m.
- ► Non-Recurring Pressures of £857k.
- ► Recurring Savings of £3.751m.



Education & Children's Services – Revenue Budget 2022/23 – Savings (1)

- Implementation of Corporate Workforce Management Target of 4% - £2,029,000
- Reduction of 6fte Teachers in Primary Schools from reducing rolls -£344,000
- Saving in School Supply Contingency budget £100,000
- ▶ Property Costs reduction NDR £135,000
- Reduction in Supplies & Services e.g. Photocopying, Stationery etc£88,000
- ► Full Removal of Playstart £87,000
- ► Criminal Justice Service (CJS) £50,000



Education & Children's Services – Revenue Budget 2022/23 – Savings (2)

- ► Further reduction of Management posts £42,000
- ► Targeted reduction in Energy Consumption within ECS Establishments £180,000 delayed until 2023/24
- ► Council Wide Travel Cost Savings £13,000
- Securing the Future of the School Estate £177,000 delayed until 2023/24
- Reduce Early Years Support Team Teachers £37,000
- ► Strategic Review of Catering Services £450,000

- Perth High School £10.4m revised budget £68.7M
- ▶ Blairgowrie Recreation Centre £2.7m revised budget £26.7m
