



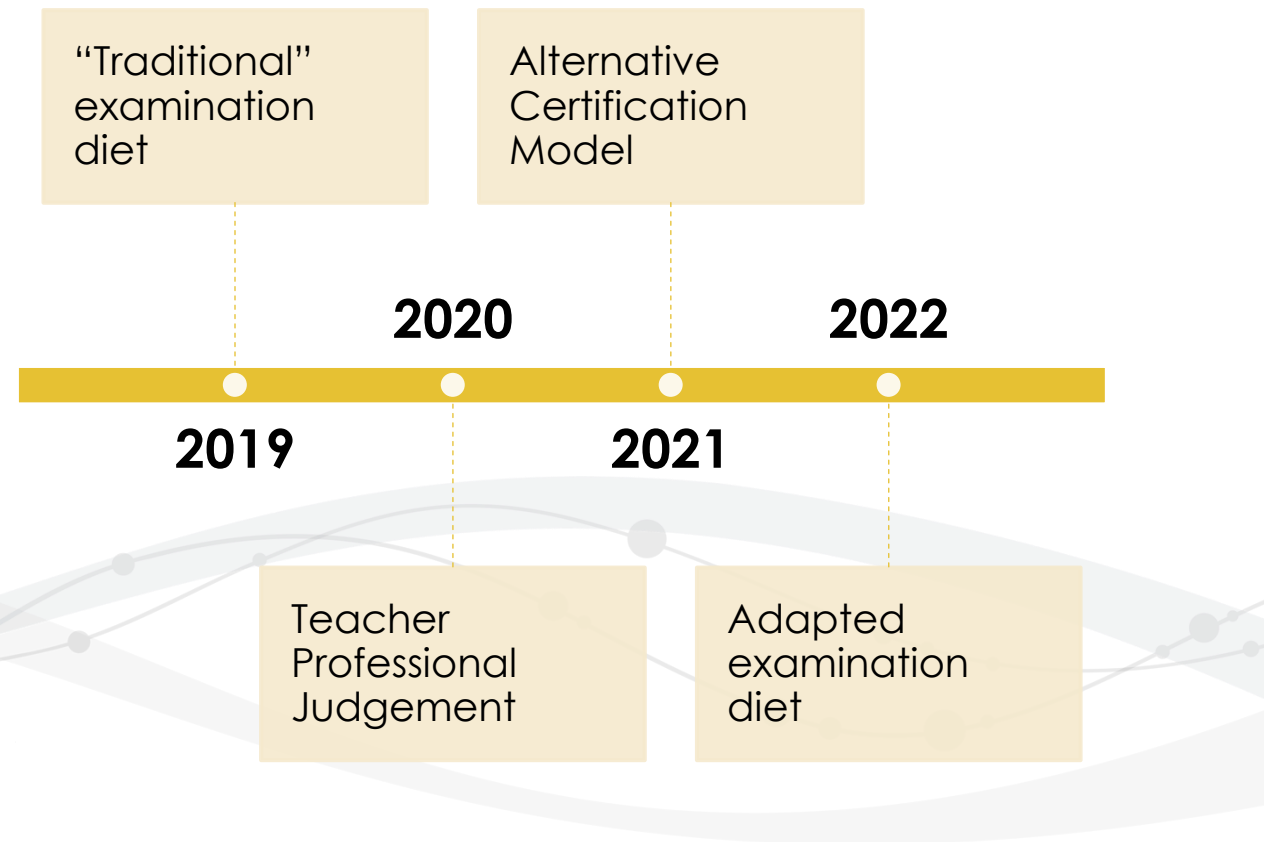

# Adaptations to SQA courses



In August 2021- adaptations made to reduce the load and scope of assessment required- for example in N5 English only one piece of folio writing required rather than two



Further adaptations published in March 2022 in response to Covid related disrupted learning- for example in N5 English there is greater direction as to the set text question.

# Teacher Estimates



These are not an evaluation of how well a young person may perform in the eventual examination but rather a judgement based solely on available assessment evidence.



These estimates are not used to determine an eventual grade and are purely evidence based. This is a significant change from the previous two sessions

If a candidate is too unwell to sit an exam their grade will be determined by SQA scrutiny of evidence held by the school/centre



Candidates may appeal if their grade is at least one full grade below the school estimate. Their final grade will be determined as above but with no detriment.
