The Council is looking to appoint two representatives of the Parent Council's, one from Primary and another from Secondary, in Perth and Kinross Council schools to serve on the Council's Learning and Families Committee – one to represent the primary school sector and one to represent the secondary school sector.

The Committee comprises 15 elected members of the Council and 9 non-Council members. Together with the 2 teacher representatives, the non-Council members comprise 3 religious representatives and 2 parent council representatives – one from the primary and one from the secondary sectors. Only the elected members on the Committee have voting rights.

The Committee and its Executive Sub-Committee each meet 5 times per annum. All meetings are held in public in the Council Chambers, 2 High Street, Perth, and can also be accessed virtually via Microsoft Teams. The meetings are broadcast live via Microsoft Teams, and are also recorded, with a copy of the recording being available to view on the Council's YouTube page the following day.

There are also some other voluntary roles that we would like to make you aware of in terms of supporting the appeals process via the Education Appeal Committee, as indicated in the attached paper.
