The core value of our school uniform policy ensures we are all equal and united. We believe that our school uniform creates a sense of identity and community for our school and its pupils, reduces peer pressure for the latest clothes and helps children feel settled and prepared for lessons.

Please use our school uniform supplier <u>Scotcrest</u> to purchase embossed items of uniform or contact Crieff ConneXions to check their supply. Other items can be bought from other suppliers such as supermarkets. *If anyone is struggling to afford uniform, please email/call the school and we will endeavour to help.* 

Pupils not adhering to this school uniform policy will have to wear spare school clothing (if available) when attending excursions or representing the school.

### P1-P7 pupils school uniform comprises of:

- Embossed School Jacket (we offer 3 different types: <u>Sirocco</u> is lightweight; <u>Reversible</u> is with a fleece on one side and <u>Parka jacket</u> is a cosy quilted lined jacket). Or plain bottle green jacket – not khaki.
- 2. Key ring of your child's choice attached to the zipper of their school jacket to enable easy identification.
- 3. Tie (green and gold striped)
- 4. **Embossed** Jumper (green, v neck, knitted <u>cotton</u> or <u>wool</u>).

**Or** plain bottle green supermarket knitted jumper – *not cardigans*.

- 5. White Shirt not polo tops.
- 6. Grey Trousers, shorts or skirts not black, no leggings and no gingham attire.
- 7. White/grey socks OR grey/green tights not black
- 8. Black outdoor school shoes
- 9. Black indoor shoes

#### P1-P7 pupils school PE kit comprises of:

- Embossed PE gold <u>polo top</u>
   Or plain gold supermarket polo top
- Embossed green v-neck <u>sweatshirt</u>
   Or plain bottle green supermarket v-neck sweatshirt
- 3. <u>Green shorts</u> and/or green joggers (2 types available: <u>lined</u> or <u>jersey</u>) *not black and no leggings*.
- Embossed green <u>PE Bag</u>.
   Or plain bottle green supermarket PE bag.
- 5. Please ensure your child brings trainers (any colour) to change into with their PE kit.

Other items available for purchase but are not mandatory are embossed sunhats, beanies, school bags and blazers.



All items of school wear must be clearly labelled – staff will always help return labelled clothing to its owner. The school is not accountable for unlabelled or lost items.



Homework bags are supplied by the school (funded by the parent council) and will be distributed with homework.



ELC also have yellow/green embossed sweatshirts available but are not essential.

#### **Health and Safety**

Hair longer than shoulder length should be fully tied up during the school day (not half up or worn down).

Nail varnish and jewellery are not encouraged. All jewellery should be removed for all PE (please provide something safe for your child to store these in).

If you child is **unable to remove their own earrings**, please ensure these are removed before coming to school or provide micropore tape for your child so they may cover their own earrings.

Staff are not responsible for removing jewellery. The school is not liable for any loss or damaged jewellery worn to school.
