Christmas Party Day, Monday 22nd December

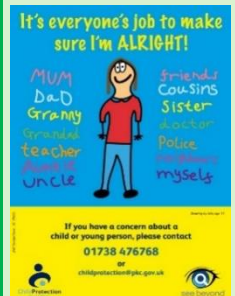
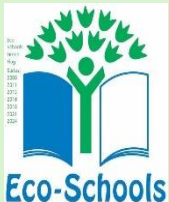
