Toilet Update

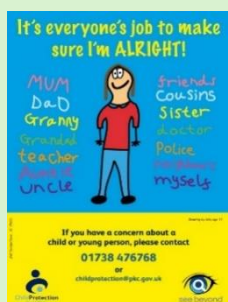
